

Off and Running!

At the beginning of a marathon the runners need to know the time the race starts, where to sign in, the location of the starting line, and a clearly marked course to bring them to the finish line. Once they know what the race looks like, they're ready to run until they cross the finish line! Scripture charges us to "run with endurance the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith." (Hebrews 12:1-2) We don't run this race of life alone. Jesus Christ shows us the way and runs with us, encouraging and challenging us to follow His example of trusting and serving God the Father.

Sunday, September 11th we begin our fall message series, "Living the Christ Life", in which we explore our values; the way we run our race for Jesus Christ:
